



Lockwood Little League Season Rules & Parent Code of Conduct

1. Season Rules & Expectations

- National Little League rules always apply
- No alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or drugs at league events
- No dogs allowed at the complex
- Mandatory fundraiser participation
- Respect toward umpires and volunteers is required. Abusive language, badgering of umpires, volunteers, or umpires will not be tolerated.
- No leaving the field in protest
- Teams must clean dugouts and spectator areas after games, including emptying the garbage cans
- No climbing on fences or unsafe behavior
- Each team must complete assigned concession shifts. The team parent will be notified of the times and communicate it to the parents.
- All volunteers must complete required background checks prior to participation.

Expectations

- Encourage participation for fun, learning, and growth
- Emphasize effort and development over winning
- Recognize the effort expended by the volunteer personnel and present opinions and criticisms to officers of the league in writing and in a constructive manner
- Communicate medical or safety concerns to coaches
- Model sportsmanship and emotional control
- Treat all participants and volunteers with respect
- Refrain from yelling, profanity, or unsportsmanlike conduct
- Allow coaches to coach without interference
- Respect umpire decisions and address concerns privately
- Support a drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free environment
- Help foster an inclusive and welcoming league culture
